




LANGUAGE

RELIGION






Popular figures







Interior of an early Ottoman mosque in Edirne



- Two of seven marvels of the world were in Anatolia: Artemis's temple in Efesus and the mausoleum in Halicarnasus (Bodrum).


CURIOSITIES






